

COMMONWEALTH CONSTITUTIVE STATUTES AND MULTILATERAL DIPLOMATIC CHARTER

STATUTE 1, ARTICLE 1: Commonwealth Constitutive, Constituency, Constitutional & Constituent Codex:

1A. The <u>Commonwealth-Citizens or Commonwealthians</u>, <u>Commonwealth-Multilateral-Diplomatic-Bodies</u>, <u>Commonwealth-Kingdoms</u>, <u>Commonwealth-Nations</u>, <u>Commonwealth-States</u>, <u>Commonwealth-Governments & Commonwealth-Authorities</u>; inviolately united, into the <u>United-Supranational-&-Multilateral-Commonwealth (US&MC) or the United Commonwealthdom (UC)</u>; Providently-Acting-Within: Allied <u>Jurisdictional-Jurisprudence</u>, <u>Constitutional-Framework</u>, <u>International-Law</u>, <u>Codicil-Godly-Scriptural-Codex</u> & <u>Temporal-Eternal-Heritage</u>.

1B. The Commonwealth is Endowed-In-Perpetuity, with <u>Supranational-Authority-&-Juridical-Personality</u> belonging to an <u>Allied Multilateral Diplomatic Inter-Governmental Commonwealth</u> cum <u>Citizen-Commonwealthdom</u> or <u>Allied-Commonwealth</u> and is inviolately empowered, with, <u>inherent cum implied Statutes and Extra-Territorial Privileges-&-Immunities</u>.

STATUTE 2, ARTICLE 1: Commonwealth-Multilateral-&-Diplomatic-System, Commonwealth & Commonwealthdom (C):

2. The Commonwealth-Multilateral-Diplomatic-System (CMDS) or the Commonwealthdom (C), via, Inviolate; Individual and Collective, Credential and Codicil of the Constituent-Polity-Body-Charters of all set Allied-Zone Multilateral-Diplomatic-Societal-Systems, namely the: UN-&-UN-States-SWF-Multilateral-Diplomatic-System; WBG-&-WBG-SWF-Multilateral-Diplomatic-System; ECB-&-ECB-SWF-Multilateral-Diplomatic-System; BEAC-&-BEAC-SWF-Multilateral-Diplomatic-System; BCEAO-&-BCEAO-SWF-Multilateral-Diplomatic-System; BRICS-BANK-&-BRICS-SWF-Multilateral-Diplomatic-System; CIS-&-CIS-SWF-Multilateral-Diplomatic-System; CON-&-CON-SWF-Multilateral-Diplomatic-System, AOSIS-&-AOSIS-SWF-Multilateral-Diplomatic-System, Holy-Land-&-Holy-Land-SWF-Multilateral-Diplomatic-System, Holy-See-&-Vatican-SWF-Multilateral-Diplomatic-System, via Addenda-AZ-1.

STATUTE 2, ARTICLE 2: Allied Governmental, Legislational, Judicial & Multilateral Authorities of the Commonwealth:

- 3.1. Authority of the Heads of Commonwealthory;

- 3.3. Authority of the Governor-Generals,
- 3.4. Authority of the Presidents

The afore-listed Authorities of the Commonwealth are augmented by the <u>Allied Regal Collegiality (ARC)</u>, <u>Allied Cadre Collegiality (ACC)</u>, the <u>Commonwealth Peerage & Patronage Collegiality (CP&PG)</u>, the <u>Allied Multilateral-&-Diplomatic Collegiality (AM&DC)</u> and the <u>Allied Governmental-Collegiality (CGC)</u> alternately titled, the Commonwealth-General-Assembly (CGA), with <u>Allied-Zone Diplomatic-Privileges-&-Immunities</u> via the <u>Credential-Prerogative of the Authority of the Heads Commonwealthory</u>.

The above, Allied-Authorities, are further augmented with the relevant Allied Ad-Hoc and Permanent Delegate-Institutions, such as the Commonwealth-Legislators-Collegiality, Commonwealth-Judicators-Justices-Judges-Jurists-And-Jurors-Collegiality, Commonwealth-Ambassadors-Collegiality, Commonwealth-Commandants-Collegiality, Commonwealth-Chaplains-Collegiality and other Accredited Allied-Collegialities of Society & State.



STATUTE 5, ARTICLE 1: Commonwealth Diplomatic Privileges, Immunities, Neutrality & Extra-Territoriality:

The Commonwealth is Endowed-In-Perpetuity, with Supranational-Authority-&-Juridical-Personality belonging to an Allied Multilateral-Diplomatic Inter-Governmental Commonwealth cum Citizen-Commonwealth and is inviolately empowered, with, inherent cum implied Statutes and Extra-Territorial Privileges-&-Immunities.

STATUTE 5, ARTICLE 2: Commonwealth Neutrality & Immunity from Judicial Proceeding:

The Commonwealth is endowed with immunity from every form of legal process. No action shall be brought against the Commonwealth by any Host-Domicile, or by any of its agencies or instrumentalities or by any entity or person(s), directly or indirectly acting for or deriving claims from the Host-Domicile or from any of its agencies or instrumentalities. The Host-Domicile shall have recourse to such special procedures for any remedial settlement between the Commonwealth and its Members as may be prescribed hereto, on mutual-conciliation, or in the by-laws and regulations of the Commonwealth (C), or in contracts entered into with the Commonwealth. Property of the Commonwealth shall, wherever located and by whomever held, be immune from all forms of seizure, attachment or execution. All Allied Multilateral Diplomatic Institutions and Accredited Officials of the Commonwealth System, shall permanently and perpetually, uphold Allied-Zone Neutrality and Inviolately-Abstain from Third-Party-Embargo-&-Sanction-Programs.

STATUTE 5, ARTICLE 3: Commonwealth Diplomatic-Headquarters & Multilateral-Zone(s) Inviolability:

The Diplomatic-Headquarters-Zone(s) of the Commonwealth, are inviolable, and under the exclusive control and authority of the Commonwealth. The Commonwealth shall have the power to make rules and regulations, operative within the headquarter-zone(s), for the full independent exercise of its Diplomatic-Multilateral Mandate(s) and Commonweal Functions. Authorities of the Host-Domicile, shall not enter the Diplomatic-Headquarter-Zone(s), without the written and Protocol Authorization, of the Commonwealth.

STATUTE 5, ARTICLE 4: Commonwealth Headquarter Adjunct-Services:

The appropriate authorities, of the Host-Domicile, upon the request of the Commonwealth, shall ensure that the Commonwealth (C) shall be provided with Addendum-Services, via Allied-Constituent-Addenda.

STATUTE 5, ARTICLE 5: Commonwealth Communications:

All Communications to and from the Commonwealth, by whatever means or in whatever form transmitted, shall inviolately be immune from censorship and any other form of interception or interference with their privacy. The Commonwealth shall have the right to use codes and to dispatch and receive official correspondence and, without limitation by reason of this enumeration, publications, documents, sound recordings, et-cetera, either by courier or in sealed-bags which shall have immunities and privileges. The Commonwealth is authorized to operate at the Headquarter-Zone(s) telecommunication grid circuits, internet, intranet, multimedia, television, radio, satellite or transmission-sites, as may be required. The Commonwealth is also authorized to operate telecommunication circuits with member-territorialities and international organizations within or outside the set Host-Domicile.

STATUTE 5, ARTICLE 6: Commonwealth Property-Inviolability & Non-Taxation:

Commonwealth Property, wherever domiciled, is immune from search, requisition, confiscation, expropriation and any other form of interference or taking or foreclosure by executive or legislative action. Commonwealth Property, includes and is not limited to Commonwealth Assets, Properties, Infrastructure, Real Estate, Funds, Monies, Currencies, Securities, Equities, Bullion, Accounts, Budgets, Portfolios, Endowments, Bodies, Machinery, Equipment, Citadel-liners, Vessels, Vehicles, Satellites, Titles, Patents, Intellectual-Property, Instruments, Territory or Rights belonging or administered by the Commonwealth. The archives of the Commonwealth are inviolable and its properties and its operations shall be exempt from all taxation and any obligation for the payment, withholding or collection of any taxes, tariffs, tolls, levies or surcharges.

STATUTE 5, ARTICLE 7: Commonwealth Officials & Representatives Diplomatic-Privileges:

Officials and Representatives of the Commonwealth, are endowed with: (a) Immunity from personal arrest or detention and from seizure of their personal baggage; (b) Immunity from legal process of every kind in respect of words spoken or written and all acts done by them in their official capacity; and (c) In respect of other matters not covered in (a) and (b) above, cum such other immunities, exemptions and privileges. Officers and Representatives of the Commonwealth shall also enjoy: (a) Exemption from taxation on or in respect of the salaries and emoluments paid by the Commonwealth; (b) Immunity, together with their spouses, dependents, and members of their household staffs, from immigration restrictions, (c) Repatriation facilities in time of crisis, together with their spouses, dependents and members of their household staffs; (f) The right to import, through the medium of the Commonwealth, free of duty and other levies and restrictions on imports, (g) The right to export, free of duty and other levies, or restrictions on exports, through the medium of the Commonwealth. All persons enjoying the privileges and immunities specified in this Diplomatic-Protocol-Instrument shall be provided by the Commonwealth with special identity-card credential which shall serve to identify the holder(s) and to certify that the holder enjoys the privileges and immunities specified in this Diplomatic-Protocol-Instrument.

STATUTE 6, ARTICLE 1: External Foreign Relations:

Commonwealth External-Foreign-Relations, shall be regulated, by set, Allied-Supplementary-Diplomatic-Protocol-Instruments-&-Institutions.

STATUTE 7, ARTICLE 1: Commonwealth-Citizen Bill-of-Rights Codicil; Commonwealth-Householder-Codex, Commonwealth Diplomatic Passport & Commonwealth International Passport Credential-Framework:

The Credential of the <u>Commonwealth Diplomatic Passport</u> cum <u>Commonwealth International Passport</u> and set Codex-Codicils, in favor of Commonwealth-Citizens & Commonwealthian-Householders, shall be recurrently coordinated with relevant Allied Bodies and Governments.

STATUTE 8, ARTICLE 1: Allied-Zone Commonwealth Regal, Regnant, Regency, Regimen & Reserve Powers:

8.A. The Regal, Regnant, Regency, Regimen & Reserve Powers of the Allied-Zone and Commonwealth-System, by Heredity-Portfolio, are Perpetually, Assigned to the Authority of the Heads of Commonwealthory (AHC) cum Commonwealthor-&-Commonwealthoress-Household (C&CH), also titled, The Commonwealthory-Household, via, Concurrent-Authority and Inviolate-Posterity. The Commonwealthor-&-Commonwealthoress Household (C&CH), via Irrevocable and Immutable, Concurrent-Allegiance-&-Neutrality-Prerogative, are Endowed, with Co-Nationality-&-Co-Citizenship of: the Commonwealth; Commonwealthory-Islands-&-Islets; Commonwealth-Islands-&-Isles; Holy-See Commonwealth, Holy-Land Commonwealth, CPECR-Commonwealth, American Commonwealth; Canadian Commonwealth; Switzerland Commonwealth; South-African Commonwealth; Australian Commonwealth; Japanese Commonwealth; Eurasian Commonwealth; Chinese Commonwealth; Indian Commonwealth; Argentinean Commonwealth; Brazilian Commonwealth, EU and GCC (Abroad) Commonwealth. The Commonwealth-Regal-Collegiality or the Allied-Regal-Collegiality is constituted by the: Commonwealthor-Imperator Chancellery; Commonwealthoress-Imperator Chancellery; Commonwealth-Crown-Prince Chancellery; Commonwealth-Crown-Princess Chancellery; Commonwealth-Regal-Confederator Chancellery; Commonwealth-Regal-Confederatoress Chancellery; Commonwealth -Regal-Suzerain Chancellery; Commonwealth-Regal-Islander Chancellery; Commonwealth-Regal-President Chancellery; Commonwealth-Regal-First-Lady Chancellery; Commonwealth-Regal-Chairperson Chancellery; Commonwealth-Regal-Envoy Chancellery; Commonwealth-Regal-Statesperson Chancellery: Commonwealth-Regal-Plenipotentiary Chancellery: Commonwealth-Regal-Commissionaire Chancellery: Commonwealth-Regal-Emissary Chancellery; Commonwealth-Regal-Ambassadress Chancellery; Commonwealth-Regal-Prolocutor Chancellery; Commonwealth-Regal-Comprador Chancellery; Commonwealth-Regal-Legate Chancellery, Commonwealth-Regal-Proconsul Chancellery, Commonwealth-Regal-Premier Chancellery cum concomitant Chancelleries and are aided by the set Peerage-Portfolios of the Allied=Zone via the Credential-Elector-Prerogative of the Authority of the Heads of Commonwealthory. The Commonwealthory-Peerage-&-Patronage-System (TCP&PS) is outlined in Allied-Addendum-TCP&PS-AZ-1.1.



STATUTE 9, ARTICLE 1: Commonwealth-Principal-Headquarters & Polaric-Commonwealth-Jurisdiction(s):

The Perpetual Principal Domicile of the Commonwealth (C), is the, Commonwealth-Headquarters-Territoriality (CHQST), located in the Antarctic -Hemisphere; Antarctic-Continent; Antarctic-Coastland; Antarctic-Aerospace; Antarctic-Islands; Antarctic-Archipelago; Antarctic-Isles; Antarctic-Maritime-Area; Antarctic-Zone, Antarctic-Sovereign-Jurisdiction and set Adjacent-Antarctic-Territories, via exclusive, Extra-Territorial-Jurisdiction, Ecological-Conservation-Trusteeship, cum concurrent, Commonwealthory-Islands-&-Isles, Commonwealth-Islands- &-Isles, Headquarters Jurisprudence. The Commonwealth-Headquarters-Territoriality (CHQST), is augmented by the, Arctic-Reservation-Conservational-Trusteeship -&-Intra-territorial-Confederation-Commonwealth (Arctic-Commonwealth or Allied-Commonwealth or AC).

STATUTE 10, ARTICLE 1, EEZ, CPECR & Allied-Commonwealth-Multilateral-Diplomatic-Zones:

- 10.1 The Euro-Currency-Economic-Zone (EEZ) is regulated by Allied-EEZ-Multilateral-Diplomatic-Protocol.
- 10.2. The Commonwealth-Pacific-Ecological-Conservation-Reserve (CPECR) is regulated by Allied-CPECR-Multilateral-Diplomatic-Protocol.
- 10.3. The Commonwealth Allied-Zones (CAZs) are regulated by Allied-Zone-Multilateral-Diplomatic-Protocol.



STATUTE 11, ARTICLE 1: Commonwealth, Allied-Zone & Host-Domicile Remedial-Conciliation Framework Systems:

- 11.1 Commonwealth and Allied-Zone Remedial Framework Systems, include: <u>Diplomatic & Mediation Framework Systems</u>; <u>Public Referenda Framework Systems</u>; <u>Ombudsman & Rapporteur Framework Systems</u> and <u>Arbitration</u>, <u>Adjudication & Appeal Framework Systems</u>.
- 11.2. Any Remedial-Conciliation between the Commonwealth and any Host-Domicile, concerning the interpretation or application of this Diplomatic-Protocol or any Supplementary-Instruments, which is not settled by negotiation shall be referred for final resolution to an arbitration-tribunal of three arbitrators: one to be appointed by the host-domicile, one to be appointed by the Commonwealth, and the third, who shall be Chairman of the Tribunal, to be chosen by the Commonwealth-Chief-Justice. The resolutions of the tribunal, shall be binding.

STATUTE 12, ARTICLE 1: Commonwealth-Extra-Territorial Statutes & Providential-Jurisprudence:




